Long-Term Project

Entry Criteria for Long-Term Projects

The number of plants should reflect the project's scale and demonstrating how the plants have been managed and sustained effectively over time.

Total Points: 100

Word Limit: Please ensure your submission does not exceed 1,000 words.

Image: Submit up to fifteen (15) named images (PNG or JPG format, max 2MB per image) showcasing your project.

Image Guidelines: Include images of the design, installation, and maintenance stages where applicable.

Criteria 1: Project Overview and Objectives

(Maximum Score 20 Points)

Provide a detailed description of the project, including its objectives and goals. What was the main purpose of the project, and how does it align with your long-term vision or sustainability goals?

Criteria 2: Project Execution and Milestones

(Maximum Score 25 Points)

Describe the key phases of the project, including design, planning, and implementation. Highlight important milestones, achievements, and any challenges encountered along the way.

Criteria 3: Innovation and Sustainability Integration

(Maximum Score 25 Points)

What innovative approaches or sustainable practices were incorporated into the long-term project? Focus on areas such as resource management, energy use, materials, and technology that contribute to sustainability or efficiency.

Criteria 4: Maintenance and Longevity

(Maximum Score 30 Points)

Explain how the project is being maintained for long-term success. Include details on ongoing operations, sustainability of materials or resources, and plans to ensure the project's longevity and continued positive impact.
