## Entry Criteria for Sustainability Projects

**The sustainability initiatives for the project have been crucial to driving continuous improvements, yielding long-term benefits for both the environment and the community.**

### Total Points: 100

**Word Limit:** Please ensure your submission does not exceed 1,000 words.

**Image:** Submit up to fifteen (15) named images (PNG or JPG format, max 2MB per image) showcasing your project.

**Image Guidelines:** Include images of the design, installation, and maintenance stages where applicable.

### Criteria 1: Sustainability Motivation and Objectives

*(Maximum Score 20 Points)*

Describe how the project demonstrates a commitment to reducing its environmental footprint, including efforts to minimise waste, energy consumption, and carbon emissions.

### Criteria 2: Use of Sustainable Materials

*(Maximum Score 20 Points)*

Explain how environmentally sustainable practices have been integrated into the project. Examples include:

- Energy efficiency
- Waste reduction
- Water conservation
- Use of recycled or reused products

### **Criteria 3: Resource Efficiency and Waste Management**

*(Maximum Score 20 Points)*

Provide evidence of responsible resource management, such as:

- Sustainable sourcing of eco-friendly products
- Implementation of waste-reduction, recycling, or repurposing initiatives
- Efforts to reduce the need for frequent maintenance or resource replenishment

### **Criteria 4: Innovation in Sustainability**

*(Maximum Score: 20 Points)*

Explain how your company engages with the community in sustainability initiatives.

Examples include:

- Sustainability training programs
- Community outreach or educational initiatives
- Collaboration with local groups or organisations on sustainable practices

### **Criteria 5: Long-Term Visibility and Adaptability**

*(Maximum Score: 20 Points)*

Describe clear strategies for maintaining the sustainability aspects of the project after completion. Include plans for ongoing monitoring, adaptation, and long-term viability.
