Information, Fees and Guidelines



Information, Fees and Guidelines

- a. Awards open to members only:** The Interior Plantscape Association 2025 Annual Awards are open to members of the Interior Plantscape Association (IPA) across Australia and New Zealand. The entry project must be an installation within Australia or New Zealand.

- b. Closing date:** The closing date submissions must be received by:
5 pm AEST on Monday 30 September 2025.

- c. Receipt of entries:** IPA accepts no responsibility whatsoever for entry submissions not being received. Entries that are either (a) not received or (b) received after the closing date for whatever reason will not be considered. If you have concerns that your entry may not be received (e.g., given its file size), then we would encourage you to make your submission well before the closing deadline to allow time for any such issues to be resolved.

- d. Award categories:** Members are welcome to submit multiple entries across multiple categories

1. Small Project with 50 or fewer plants
2. Medium Project with 50 – 150 plants
3. Large Project with more than 150 plants
4. Business Sustainability
5. Sustainability Project
6. Long-term project - The installation has been in place for two years or longer

Category	Description	Entry fee
Small Project	Open to any new indoor plant installation completed from 1st October 2024 – 30th September 2025 with 50 or fewer plants.	\$200 per entry (+ gst)*
Medium Project	Open to any new indoor plant installation completed from 1st October 2024– 30th September 2025 with 50–150 plants.	\$300 per entry (+ gst)*
Large Project	Open to any new indoor plant installation completed from 1st October 2024 – 30th September 2025 with more than 150 plants	\$500 per entry (+ gst)*
Business Sustainability	Open to interior plantscapers who have implemented sustainable solutions and products within their business.	\$200 per entry (+ gst)*
Sustainability Project	Open to interior plantscapers who have implemented sustainable solutions and products in a project.	\$200 per entry (+ gst)*
Long-term Project	Open to projects that have been in place for two years or longer. The number of plants should reflect the project’s scale and demonstrating how the plants have been managed and sustained effectively over time.	\$200 per entry (+ gst)*

*Please Note: NZ members do not pay GST

- e. Entry fees:** Entry fees must be received prior to the closing date (5pm AEST on Monday 30 September 2025)

Please confirm via email, what categories you are entering. Confirmation is to be sent via email no later than 20 September, 2025 to info@interiorplantscape.asn.au

Invoice for your entry fees will then be issued.

Note: Payment must be made by 5pm AEST on Monday 30 September 2025.

- f. Authority to use entry details, including photography:** By entering the 2025 awards, you give consent to the IPA to publish any part of the submission, including the photography. Publication may include via its website, on social media, and/or with its media partners.

In addition, you confirm that you own any copyright over the images submitted and that you will indemnify the IPA from any action by a third party against claims related to the use of those photographs (such as breach of copyright).

- g. Judges' decision is final:** An independent panel of three impartial judges have been appointed to judge the awards. Their decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

The judges will award one winner for each category.

To ensure 'blind judging' of all the entries, all possible ways of identifying the entrant will be removed or redacted (i.e. logos in the photos; company name or abbreviation in the description submitted, as well as the signature page of the entry form).

'Blind judging' means that all judges will receive no information or identification about the entity or business name of the entries.

The judging will be solely based on each category's entry criteria and photos submitted.

h. Entry Guidelines and Criteria:

Please make sure that you adhere to all the entry guidelines and criteria outlined in the 2025 awards entry form.

Sometimes artificial plants are used on projects, when there is no other options. If used in your installation, please highlight the reason why.

Written Description: Please limit a total of no more than 1,000 words for each entry.
